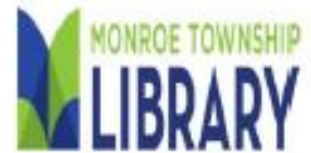

## FREECYCLING



**Freecycling**, or free recycling, is the act of giving away **usable** unwanted items to others instead of disposing of them in landfills. Bring your unwanted **usable** items and find a treasure for yourself! (**no clothing**)

## PAPER SHREDDER TRUCK

RESIDENTIAL PAPER ONLY

10am-2pm

(or until shredding truck is filled, whichever occurs first)



Paper must be in a manageable container--**No Plastic Bags Please.**

NOTE: No need to remove paper clips, staples or paperboard binder covers.

**DO NOT BRING:** Newspapers, magazines, hardcover books, junk mail, photos, x-rays, CDs, or garbage.  
Loads containing unacceptable items may be rejected.
