About Monroe Township Medical Transportation

Our Department is a Share Ride Service for routine medical appointments. Due to demand and availability, you may be required to be ready up to an hour prior to your doctor's appointment. You may also need to wait until all patients are ready at the same location, before being transported back to your residence. By complying with the above, we will be able to serve more residents at the same time.

When Calling for Reservations provide the following details:

- A minimum of 5-7 working days notice to schedule your ride
- Your name, street address, community and phone number
- Doctor's name, address and phone number

- If you are in a wheelchair or scooter, so we can dispatch the correct vehicle
- If you have a service animal or are bringing oxygen onboard
- If you require an aide's assistance, so proper space is provided

Routine Schedule

For Monroe & Jamesburg medical appointments:

Monday through Friday for appointments between 9:30 a.m.-2 p.m.

*Subject to driver availability

For Plainsboro & Princeton medical appointments:

Second and Fourth *Thursday* of every month for appointments between 9:30 a.m.-10:15 a.m.

For Hightstown medical appointments:

Third *Tuesday* of every month for appointments between 9:30 a.m.-10:30 a.m.

For Cranbury medical appointments:

Every Friday for appointments between 9:30 a.m.-11 a.m.

Cancellations – Call and/or leave a message with Monroe's Transportation Department 24 hours per day at (609) 443-0511.

If you are in need of special accommodations, please ask for Amy.

Please advise our Department if the transportation will be one-way only.
