PONDS/ENCORE/ STONEBRIDGE, RENAISSANCE @ MONROE, AND CRANBURY CROSSING:

All Buses leave from their Community's Clubhouse.

REGENCY: All buses leave from the Bus Stop in the parking lot.

ROSSMOOR: All buses leave from POOL-SIDE.

CONCORDIA and GREENBRIAR @ WHITTINGHAM: All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.

February 6th.... "On Golden Pond" @ Bristol Riverside Theatre...Join us for a humorous and heart-warming show about love, reconnection and family. This home had a very unexpected, and important visitor, British General Henry Clinton who occupied their home for 36 hours and forced the elderly Elizabeth to sleep in her milk house.
