You cannot give a third person's name even if it's for a different trip. If you are placed on our stand-by list, please keep in mind, we may possibly add another bus to this trip or we may get a different date which will be offered to the ones on stand-by. We try our best to satisfy everyone.

We do a variety of different trips so, please look at the trips carefully, since some of them require a lot of walking and uneven terrain. If you have trouble walking or have a walker then this trip isn't for you. We try to have trips for everyone.

CANCELLATIONS!

To avoid having to cancel, please check your personal calendar before calling. This helps us to serve you better. However, if you must cancel a reservation, please call our office as soon as possible or at least 2 (two) weeks before the trip. Our number is (609) 443-0511.

Please leave a message with your name, phone number and the trip date that you would like to cancel.

ROSSMOOR: All buses leave from POOL-SIDE.

CONCORDIA and GREENBRIAR @ WHITTINGHAM: All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.

REFUND POLICY

If you need to cancel for any reason, please call us as soon as possible. Refunds are granted—without a doctor's note—when you cancel two (2) weeks prior to the trip date. Otherwise, a note is required within five (5) business days of the trip date and your seat MUST be replaced. Any and all refunds will be processed within 7-10 business days after the trip. If you contact us after this time period there will be **NO REFUNDS GIVEN!**
