110TH ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, The Francis E. Parker Memorial Home Inc. is a not-for-profit long-term care organization established in 1907 in New Brunswick, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in 1983, Parker opened its second location at River Road, Piscataway, New Jersey and in 2002 Parker opened Evergreen Way, a small home focused on memory care; and

WHEREAS, Parker celebrated its 100th Anniversary in 2007 with the addition of Parker at Stonegate assisted living community and Parker at the Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, in 2008 Parker Adult Day Care opened expanding services to support people aging at home and in 2010 its Health and Wellness Center opened for adults age 55 and over living in the community; and

WHEREAS, Parker at Monroe a long-term care community was opened in 2014 and in 2016 Parker purchased McCarrick home and added post-acute rehabilitation and Medicaid-Certified and Medicare long-term care services; and

WHEREAS, we celebrate this leading organization's 110th Anniversary of changing, challenging, and expanding the idea of what it means to grow older in America and mark the launch of Parker's new #WithIt campaign;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GERALD W. TAMBURRO, Mayor of the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex, do hereby proclaim May 11, 2017 as the 110th Anniversary of Parker, and call upon all residents of Monroe Township to join me in *making aging part of life.*
