# Proclamation

**Rossmoor Jewish Congregation 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**

**April 14, 2018**

**WHEREAS**, the Rossmoor Jewish Congregation's guiding principle has been and always will be, "Behold, how good and pleasant it is for Brethren to dwell together in unity."
