

Chapter 96-2C(1-3) of the Municipal Ordinance – Required Permits; Utility operations. The Shade Tree Commission may grant to public utility companies a blanket permit for tree pruning for line clearance and for the installation of the maintenance of subsurface and above ground plant construction if there is interference with or endangerment to street trees. Each public utility company shall exercise reasonable diligence in the maintenance of its plant construction so as to avoid damage to trees under the jurisdiction of the Monroe Township Shade Tree Commission. Tree work in Monroe Township shall be performed to the arboricultural guidelines described in the following publication: the <u>ANSI Z133.2012</u>, <u>Board of Tree Experts Standards</u>, <u>Pruning Trees Near Electric utilities – Shigo© 1990</u>, and all other industry BMP's including BPU vegetation standards. Violations of this permit shall nullify the approval and each violation will be considered a separate offense and may incur fines.
