Subject: BFI/Republic Landfill

Dear Residents,

I am writing to you with great pleasure to report that construction of the dedicated force main at the Landfill is now complete and operational. As you know, the Township implemented this force main because we recognized it is the safest method of leachate disposal from the Landfill, and the force main eliminates the need for further trucking through the Inwood Estates neighborhood.

The force main now carries leachate from the Landfill site to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority, without any laterals to residences. We contracted with KMetz, Inc. to install more than 8,000 feet of double wall containment pipe underground between Lani Street and pump station #6. The Township also hired DeMaio Electric Co., Inc., to construct a new state-of-the-art pump station to direct the Landfill's leachate to the new force main. Both phases of this project were completed with the highest quality equipment and materials to ensure residents' safety. Both the pump station and force main are operating as designed.

I want to personally thank all of you for your patience and understanding throughout this construction and the trucking operation. Next year I also look forward to improving roads in the neighborhood, partially through a State transportation grant which will cover a portion of those costs. As always, the safety of Monroe residents is my number-one priority.
