<u>JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE AND APPRECIATION MONTH</u> <u>MAY 2024</u>

WHEREAS, Monroe Township has a strong Jewish community as an

important part of the town's fabric, including members at Chabad House of Monroe, Chabad Jewish Center of Monroe and Etz Chaim Monroe Township Jewish Center contributing in many ways to the strength and resilience of our community; and

WHEREAS, throughout our history, Jewish people have helped advance

society through science, politics, journalism, arts and entertainment, literature, commerce, human rights and more;

and

WHEREAS, this community of neighbors, friends, colleagues and family

members has offered much in the way of innovation, creativity, and lasting contributions to our common knowledge, but has also historically been subject to discrimination, hatred and

violence that we continue to struggle with today; and

WHEREAS, antisemitism impacts millions of Jews and people of all backgrounds

around the globe. The Anti-Defamation League tracks antisemitic incidents, and in 2022 recorded 3,697 incidents of assault, harassment and vandalism against Jewish people in the U.S., the highest number

recorded since they began monitoring these trends in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Monroe Township strongly stands against hate, bias or violence

based on race, nationality, gender, disability, or religion and encourages victims or witnesses of antisemitism or hate in Monroe

to report it to the Monroe Township Police; and

WHEREAS, we are pleased to recognize and celebrate the resilience, faith,

and heritage of this community, whose values, culture, and contributions have shaped our culture through the years and

will continue to do so into the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEPHEN DALINA, Mayor of the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex, New Jersey do hereby proclaim the month of May 2024 to be designated **as Jewish American Heritage and Appreciation Month** in

Monroe Township.
