# Proclamation

**FLAG DAY  
JUNE 14, 2025**

**WHEREAS,** in the United States, **Flag Day** is celebrated on **June 14th**; and

**WHEREAS,** it commemorates the adoption of the flag of the United States which happened that day by resolution of the Second Continental Congress in 1777; and


**WHEREAS,** in 1917, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day; and

**WHEREAS,** on August 3, 1949, President Harry S. Truman signed an Act of Congress designating **June 14** of each year as **National Flag Day**; and

**WHEREAS,** the "Stars and Stripes" are the National symbol of the United States of America and its display reminds us daily of America's promise and guides us toward a brighter tomorrow.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, STEPHEN DALINA, MAYOR** of the Township of Monroe urge all residents to display the flag and observe with pride those days from Flag Day through Independence Day, as a time to honor America, to celebrate our heritage in public gatherings and activities, and to publicly recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.
