WHEREAS, senior centers are key resources for individuals to age healthily and gateways for communities to properly support older adults; and

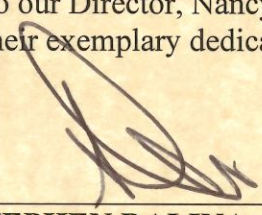
