Subject: BFI/Republic Landfill

Dear Residents,

In keeping with my regular updates, I am writing to communicate our progress toward the construction of a dedicated force main to resolve the leachate disposal problem at the Landfill. As you know, the Township awarded a contract to KMetz, Inc. to construct the force main. The contractor has completed the drilling of test pits and adjusted the profile of the force main route to avoid conflicts with other utilities. We have received delivery of approximately 16,000 feet of pipe, and the contractor will begin pipe installation in June.

The Township awarded a contract to DeMaio Electric Co., Inc., in March to construct a small pump station to direct the Landfill's leachate to the force main. We are finalizing the acquisition of necessary easements in order to begin installation in the coming weeks. I also directed our environmental consultant to conduct air sampling around the perimeter of the landfill. Those results are expected in approximately two weeks, at which point I will schedule another community meeting to discuss and answer any questions.

As always, the safety of Monroe residents is my number-one priority. I will continue to communicate with Inwood Estates residents, and all residents, at every phase of this project until it is completed.
