ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE SECTION 108-5.27 ENTITLED "STORMWATER MANAGEMENT"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that Section 108-5.27 of the code of the Township of Monroe entitled "Stormwater Management" is hereby amended to include the following: (new text is in red and <u>underlined</u>)

SECTION 1.

Section II. Definitions:

"Environmentally constrained area" means the following areas where the physical alteration of the land is in some way restricted, either through regulation, easement, deed restriction or ownership such as wetlands, floodplains, threatened or endangered species sites and designated habitats, and parks and preserves. Habitats of endangered or threatened species are identified using the Department's Landscape Project as approved by the Department's Endangered and Nongame Species Program.

Section X. Maintenance and Repair:

- B. General Maintenance
- 7. The party responsible for maintenance identified under Section X.B.3 above shall perform all of the following requirements:
 - i. maintain a detailed log of all preventative and corrective maintenance for the structural stormwater management measures incorporated into the design of the development, including a record of all inspections and copies of all maintenance-related work orders;
 - ii. evaluate the effectiveness of the maintenance plan at least once per year and adjust the plan and the deed as needed; and
 - iii. retain and make available, upon request by any public entity with administrative, health, environmental, or safety authority over the site, the maintenance plan and the documentation required by Section X.B.6 and B.7 above.
 - iv. post a two-year maintenance guarantee in accordance with N.J.S.A.40:55D-53
- **SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after final passage, adoption and publication as provided by law.
