ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL AMENDING CHAPTER 122 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 122-35 of the Code of the Township of Monroe, entitled "Schedule VI; Trucks Over Four Tons Excluded" shall be amended as follows: (new text is in red and underlined)

In accordance with the provisions of § 122.11, trucks over four (4) tons gross weight are hereby excluded from the following described streets or parts of streets except for the pickup and delivery of materials on such streets or the transport of individuals to and from locations on such streets:

SECTION 2. Chapter 122-44.1. entitled "Schedule XVA" of the Code of the Township of Monroe, which Section establishes "Speed Limits" within the Township of Monroe shall be amended as follows: (new text is in red and <u>underlined</u>, text to be deleted is struck)

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
