NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK

April 10-16, 2022

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Monroe Township Police Department have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,

WHEREAS, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;
