

GENERAL ELECTION INFORMATION

Due to the ongoing novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, a new state law (P.L. 2020, c. 72) became effective on August 28, 2020 which requires County Clerks to send all active registered voters a Vote-by-Mail Ballot for the upcoming November 3, 2020 General Election.

Register to Vote

To participate in the General Election, you must be registered to vote in Middlesex County by Tuesday, October 13, 2020.

Register to vote or update your registration:

- Online
- By mail using the Voter Registration Application
- In person at the County Clerk's office or the Board of Elections
- While applying for or renewing your driver's license at Motor Vehicle facilities

Ways To Vote

Return your ballot through the United States Postal Service.

Place your ballot in one of the Middlesex County Board of Elections drop boxes. Please visit www.middlesexcountynj.gov/vote2020 for a list of convenient drop box locations in Middlesex County. If you have any questions please contact the Board of Elections at 732-745-3471.

Drop off your ballot at the Board of Elections Office in East Brunswick.

A bearer, someone a voter authorizes to transport the voter's completed Vote-by-Mail ballot, may deliver another voter's ballot to the Board of Elections or a drop box. You may only serve as a bearer for a total of 3 voters.

Submit your ballot at your assigned polling location in-person on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

However, bearers are prohibited from delivering another individual's ballot to a polling location.

If you have a disability and need an accessible Vote-By-Mail ballot, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 732-745-4202.

Voting In-Person

If you do not receive a Vote-By-Mail Ballot or wish to vote in-person, you can vote by paper provisional ballot at a polling place that will be determined by the Board of Elections.

- A limited number of polling places will be available for voters on Election Day. Voters who choose to vote in-person may vote only by paper provisional ballot at their assigned polling location. Voters also have the option to return their own Vote-By-Mail Ballot at their assigned polling location. There are more than 95 polling locations throughout the County with at least one in every municipality.
- Polling locations will adhere to CDC social distancing guidelines and voters and those accompanying them will be required to wear a mask.

Accommodations will be made for voters with a disability at their assigned polling location.

If you are a disabled voter and need access to an ADA accessible ballot marking device to vote on November 3, please call the Middlesex County Board of Elections at 732-745-3471.
